

Amarillo's Million Dollar Duck Race



This duck could be worth One Million!

SUMMARY OF OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE AMARILLO MILLION DOLLAR DUCK RACE

Presented by Wonderland Park and Texas Panhandle Independent Futures Foundation (TPIFF) (not-for-profit corporation with IRS designations as 503(c)(3) corporation), hereinafter referred to as "PRESENTER".

1. Ducks will be launched into Wonderland Park Large Water Ride at approximately 2:00 P.M. on August 10, 2014.
2. A maximum of 5,000 rubber ducks will be entered into the race. All ducks entered will be provided by PRESENTER and shall remain the property of PRESENTER.
3. A number will be attached to each duck relating to the number on the duck adoption application. Multiple duck entries from one duck adoption application will be assigned additional duck numbers for identification.
4. Each duck adoption application must be completed in full online or delivered to PRESENTER or an authorized representative of PRESENTER or mailed to TPIFF, PO Box 1233, Amarillo, TX 79105. Adoptions online at www.MillionDollarDuckRace.com.
5. No purchase is necessary in order to enter to win. PRESENTER does request a donation of \$10.00 per entry to benefit TPIFF housing and services to physically disabled young adults. Online "Adopt-A-Duck" will close at 12 midnight on Saturday, August 9th, 2014.
6. Winners will be announced at the Duck Race Awards Ceremony at approximately 3:00 P.M. on August 10th, 2014. Entrants will, where necessary, also be notified by the United States mail or telephone. Race winners need not be present to win.

MILLION DOLLAR DUCK RULES

Grand Prize Procedure – PRESENTER will host a duck race during the promotion date(s). Each duck will be marked with a unique number from a number range provided by the PRESENTER. Once ducks are released into the water, the first predetermined number of ducks, as established by the PRESENTER, which cross the finish line are finalists in the promotion. A Finalist is a promotion prize winner if their number matches in sequence to the winning number as picked by Grand Prize Promotions (“GPP”).

Winning Number – GPP will randomly select one (1) number from each block of 1,500 numbers from the number range provided by PRESENTER (see Prize Value & Promotion Prize below). These numbers are the only potential winning numbers. GPP will send the PRESENTER a security-sealed envelope containing the winning numbers. **The envelope is to remain sealed until otherwise instructed by GPP.**

Promotion Hotline – GPP will provide to the Sponsor access to a promotion hotline to verify promotions results.

Verification – Once Finalists have been determined and PRESENTER has made connection with the Promotion Hotline, the PRESENTER will be asked to enter each Finalist’s number. If a Finalist’s number matches the winning number, the PRESENTER will be advised that there is a winner. If the Finalists’ numbers do not match the winning number, the PRESENTER will be advised that there is no winner in the promotion.

Promotion Conclusion – If the Promotion Hotline indicates a winner in the promotion, the sealed envelope must be returned unopened to GPP within a period of five (5) business days. If the Promotion Hotline indicates no winner in the promotion, GPP will then give authorization to the PRESENTER to open the envelope and verify the winning number. **No promotion prize will be awarded once the sealed envelope is opened.**

Witnesses – Two (2) PRESENTER representatives or officials, age 18 or older, of good moral character, must witness the promotion. The witnesses are responsible for the Finalists’ understanding of the terms and conditions of the promotion. An additional independent witness will be required. This witness will be setup by GPP and paid for by the PRESENTER.

IN THE EVENT OF A TIE – Should a tie occur where the PRESENTER is unable to determine which duck crossed the finish line first, PRESENTER may use a coin flip or other fair and suitable method to determine the Finalist which attempt to win the promotion prize.

Prize Distribution – The \$1 Million prize, if awarded, will be payable in 40 annual installments of \$25,000. Contest rules concerning the awarding of the \$1 Million prize are available from the PRESENTER. PRESENTER reserves the right to refuse to make the award due to any irregularity in the application of the contest rules. A schedule of payments will be announced within ten (10) days after certification of the winner, if any.

As PRESENTER of the Duck Race, the Board of Directors and employees of Texas Panhandle Independent Futures Foundation and Wonderland Park are ineligible for the Grand Prize of \$1 Million. They are eligible to participate in the Corporate Race and Million Dollar Race and if declared a winner, they are eligible to receive all prizes except the \$1 Million Grand Prize.

In the event GPP, the insurer, fails to discharge their payment of obligations to any such winner, the \$1 Million Duck winner agrees to release The First Amarillo Million Dollar Duck Race, and PRESENTER, and their officers, directors and staff and other related entities from any and all liability of nonpayment of a legitimate claim owed by GPP and such winner agrees to look solely to GPP, or the insurer for such payments. Any and all winners agree to allow PRESENTER to use their name and likeness for promotional purposes without further compensation.
